



In Case You Missed Our Annual Meeting in February.....

Thank you to all who attended Concordia's Annual Meeting in February. Congratulations and thank you to Debby Whelpley and Eric Holloway who were re-elected to serve on the Church Council.

An update was given on our search for a pastor. In early February, congregation president Ginny Hassseler spoke with Rachel Sosbee, the ELCA Upstate NYsynod representative, who stated that no prospective pastoral candidates have inquired about our listing for a pastor. She said that nationally there are 541 sites looking to call a pastor, but there are only 389 profiles in the system.

Our search committee- Kathy Robertson, Donna Dutton, Ginny Hasseler, and Jason Comet (in an advisory capacity since he is not an official member of Concordia)- would love to have 2 or 3 more voting members of the church join the Search Committee. No experience is required, only a desire to find someone who seems like a good fit for Concordia. If you are interested, see Ginny. We are still working with the Theresa Presbyterian Church to share a pastor since neither of us can afford to call a full-time person, and we think there is a better chance of getting someone if together, we can offer a full-time position.

In March 2024 the congregation gave approval for the Council to rent the parsonage to cover taxes since we lost our property tax exemption when there was not a pastor living in the parsonage. North Star Property Management Co. was hired to manage the renting, and although it took longer than anyone anticipated, the parsonage was finally rented in December 2024. This has eased the burden on our property chairperson, Sid Wheeler, and also brings in some income for the church.

Easter Flowers

Since we began our tradition of having the floweradorned large cross in our sanctuary for Easter, the flowers have been provided as memorials by the children of John and Rosina Schneider who were long-time members of Concordia.

We are very grateful for the generosity of the Schneider family over the years, but due to some personal health matters in the family, our church council has decided to invite Concordia's congregation to purchase the plants this year in honor of or in memory of those they wish to honor or remember. **Plants are \$20.00 each**. Two plants will be allocated in honor of and also in memory of the Schneiders. The **sign up sheet for Easter Cross Flowers** is posted on the bulletin board in the fellowship hall if you want to purchase any. You may take your plant home when the cross is taken down. Place payment (labeled with your name & Easter Flowers) in the offering plate.



If you prefer to provide other flowers for Easter, you are welcome to purchase a plant of your choosing at a store, bring it to beautify our church, and then take it home again after the worship service.

I'm Staff Sergeant Tolbert, the NOCIC of the TF Woverine S3. My role here is multifaceted – I act as an advisor to my officers and prioritize the well-being of our team. Have you heard of Respite Haven? Are you a caregiver who needs a break? Or a volunteer who wants to work with seniors?

Respite Haven is a respite volunteer day program for seniors that is held 10-2, Thursdays and Fridays at River Community Church in Clayton and 10-2 Monday and Wednesday at Trinity Episcopal Church in Watertown. This program provides structured person-centered activities that include Tai Chi for beginners, memory improvement games and craft activities to name a few. A lunch will be provided for participants while socializing with other seniors. Respite provides an opportunity for caregivers to drop off their family member in a safe supervised setting so they can take a break and attend to their own personal appointments or needs.
